Summary

Write an artist statement to accompany your personal project at the final exam. The artist statement should tell about you as an artist, your experience in the class and your personal project piece that you are presenting. It should be the best example of your polished writing.

Introduction

Paragraph #1- Who are you as an artist?

Paragraph #2- What was your experience making art this semester with Art+Technology?

Paragraph #3- Explain your personal project that you are presenting.

Conclusion

Formatting

- Statement needs to be ½ to a full page **typed**- it must fit on one page
- You may choose any readable font
- Single spacing
- At the top it should say “Artist Statement” centered on the first line and your name centered underneath on the second line

Considerations

- Take time to plan out your statement before you write!
- Your statement should be your best writing- it is important to spend as much time editing as it is writing your rough draft!
- You can use first person pronouns like “I”
- It should sound conversational- imagine you are talking to someone about your work as you write
- Ask if you need help!

Grading

Your statement will be graded 60% on ideas/content, 20% on conventions and 20% on organization. See the rubric provided by the teacher for specifics on each of these areas.
