

# Cinemagraphs

## Camera

Set Image/File Size Settings- Basic or Small

Keep the camera still- Use a tripod so background does not move

Shoot a short **video** clip- 3-10 seconds

## Edit in Photoshop

File-Open

Make sure you can see your video in Layers to the right and Timeline on the bottom  
(If not, go to Window- Layers and Window-Timeline)

In the Layers, drag the Layer 1 above the Video Group 1

Drag Video Group 1 to the Trash at the bottom right of the Layers

Drag Layer 1 over the small piece of paper at the bottom of the Layers to copy it

Right-click on Video Copy and Rasterize it

With a Selection Tool click Select and Mask button on top bar

In this menu, choose View- Overlay

In this menu, choose the brush tool and brush in where you want the motion to show

In this menu, click Invert button and Output to Layer Mask

On the Timeline, adjust the range of the final video

## Export

File- Save for Web (Legacy)

Adjust GIF (check for looping, size, dither)

Save

Too big? Image- Image Size- 600 pixels x 600 pixels (approx.)
